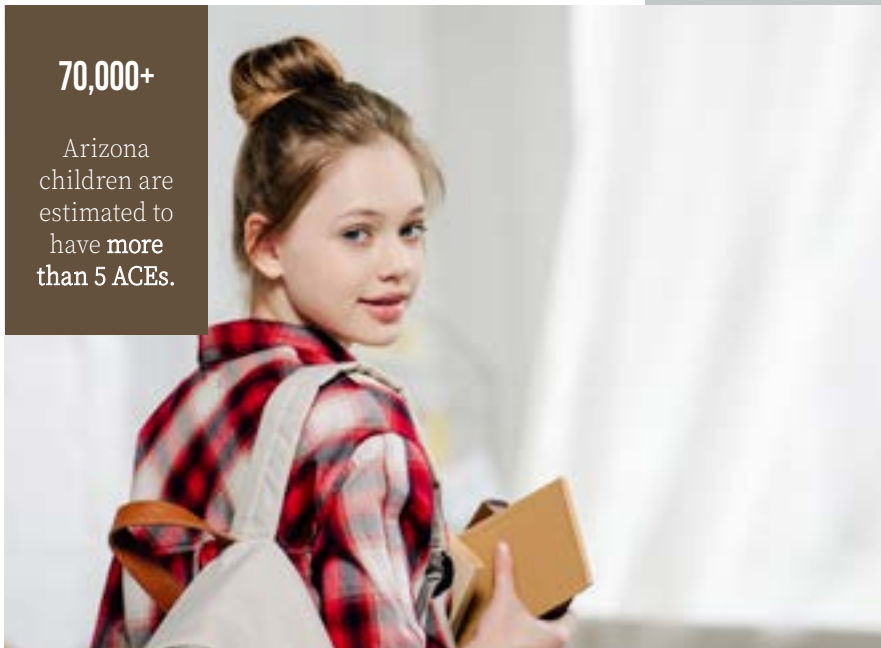


WHO WE ARE

CLINICAL SUPPORT

The Arizona ACEs Consortium has Masters of Social Workers available to support all Resiliency program participants experiencing distress, withdrawal, and retraumatization.

The MSWs connect with these individuals to provide clinical support and offer referrals to clinical care. Additionally, the MSWs will remain following the conclusion of sessions to be available to participants interested in speaking with a mental health professional.



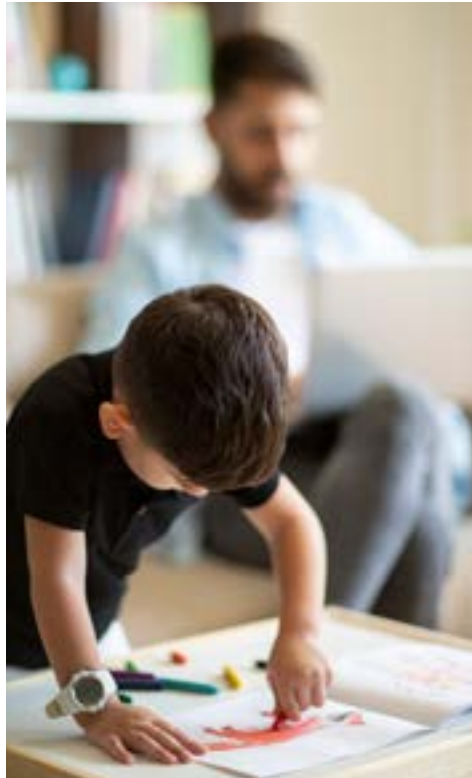
Clinical Support

Resiliency program participants may experience different emotional & physical needs.

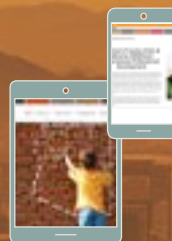
Masters of Social Work are available for in-person programs to support participants with additional insight and guidance, as well as clinical support and referrals when needed.

3 UNIQUE PROGRAMS

Find the right fit for your needs

In-person training sessions are held at sites for community organizations serving youth and families, or virtually online, as requested by leadership. All sessions are interactive and led by both a certified ACEs trainer and a Master's-level Social Worker (MSW). Training curricula are designed by Arizona-based social workers, counselors, therapists and health professionals who understand the demographics, cultures and communities represented in our local organizations.

COMMUNITY YOUTH ORGANIZATION PROGRAM

For Counselors & Staff of community youth organizations, youth from the community, and families from the community: **1 session; 4 hours total**

2

ADMINISTRATOR'S PROGRAM

For Organization Administrators and Board leadership: **1 session; 1.5 hours total**

**may be done alone, but is required for community youth organization program*

3

YOUTH ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM

For youth leaders with organizational & parental approval: **3 sessions; 3 hours total**

**may be added on with other training options*
